Resolution 2023 -186

WHEREAS, DOCKO Inc., a marine engineering firm specializing in planning, design, engineering and construction located in Mystic CT has provided professional engineering services to the FIFD for forty years and has provided valuable input and advise to the BOC on various pending projects; and

WHEREAS the Board of Commissioners of the Fishers Island Ferry District has determined that the institutional knowledge and familiarity with the District's infrastructure enables DOCKO, Inc. to provide efficient and expeditious professional services; and

WHEREAS, DOCKO, Inc. has presented a proposal to the BOC for the provision of professional engineering services for engineering / project manager at the rate of \$235.00 per hour; engineering services for engineering technician / computer drafting at the rate of \$170.00 per hour; and engineering services for project administration at the rate of \$150.00 per hour for the term ending January 2024;

WHEREAS, the BOC of the FIFD has determined that it would not be in the best interests of the taxpayers of the FIFD to seek alternative proposals or quotations from other engineering firms who do not possess DOCKO's experience and institutional knowledge.
