Chair Reid called a meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Fishers Island Ferry District (the "Ferry District") to order on March 5, 2024 at 4:00 PM at the Island Community Center and via Zoom.

Commissioners Ace Ahrens, Heather Burnham, Tom Cashel, Jim Reid and Dianna Shillo were present. Also in attendance were Geb Cook, Dave McCall, Jon Haney and Carol Murphy. Secretary Deanna Ross was absent. Members of the public included Jesse Marshal.

Chair Reid established that a quorum was present. Everyone in attendance pledged allegiance to the flag.

Correspondence/Public Comment - Mr. McCall reported he received a letter from Amy Butowicz requesting a resident card. The BOC has requested a physical address from Ms. Butowicz. A letter was received from Mr. Jim Baker requesting permission to install a pole for an Osprey nest near the airport. The BOC approves. A request was received from Mr. Jared Toldo to install metal trusses between his two containers. Mr. Toldo was directed to the building inspector, Mr. Verity.

Marine Update - Mr. Haney updated the BOC. Mr. Haney is working on the yard package for Race Point. In addition to an overhaul on the engines which are coming up on 10,000 hours, work is also needed on the haul plate. Mr. Haney reported that adding the interior passenger cabin to the yard package would add an additional \$100,000 to the total. This would include the deck, new seating and possible dinette tables. Discussion ensued. Mr. Haney will send out two proposed diagrams. Munnatawket just returned from an excellent yard period that lasted 7 weeks. Mr. Haney really enjoyed working with the project manager. Prior going into commercial service, A dead weight survey must be conducted due to the new generators that weigh less than the previous ones, as well as the re-power that was done in 2018. No stability analysis has been done since 1978. The naval architect and USCG will be out tomorrow to take the calculations and measurements. Mr. Haney feels he should know where we stand by the end of the week.

Although the boat was great for grooming upcoming captains, Mr. Haney feels efforts should continue with the two large boats. The BOC and management have agreed to sell the Silver Eel. Management will move forward with a sellers survey.

Property Lease Rates Discussion - Mr. Cook reported that leases are due back by April 1, 2024 and would like to get them all out by March 15, 2024. The BOC reviewed a lease spreadsheet. Discussion ensued. The BOC has directed management to go ahead with a 10% increase and to inform tenants that all parcels will be visited and reviewed over the remainder of 2024, with new leases in 2025.

Ferry Design RFP Update - Mr. Cook reported that he is currently seeking quotes for writing the ferry design RFP.

Corner Ramp Update - Mr. Cook reported that he received drawings from Docko. Bond money has been set aside. The corner ramp project will go out to bid this summer for work that will commence next summer.
